



Are you planning on mooring (docking) boats from your dock? We have bumper solutions to protect both dock and the boat taking harbor.





#### Added-on Stability


After surveying your lakefront, your local dealership will understand what kind of bracings footpads you may need to keep your dock stable. Here are an assortment of options they may give you.





A long time favorite, swim ladders are made of aluminum with adjustable legs. No drilling required.


Comes in 3, 4, and 5 step variants.



#### Stairs




Avaliable in tan grey and white, our stairs are a safe and trustworthy way to get people (and often dogs) in and out of the water!

#### Power Pedestal


Want water or electrical hoockup at the end of your dock? The power Pedestal is the simple solution to using them consistently, efficiently, and safely.



#### **Utility Channel**




The utility channel connects to the underside of your dock, hiding and protecting cords and hoses you may have on your dock system.
